Edit photos and videos

In this insructable I will be teaching you to make basic edits on a photo using and Apple iPad. Edit, such as cropping, making a collage, and even adding a frame or border around the pictures. You can crop a picture directly from the photo app. First, what you need to do is go to the photos app and choose the picture you want to crop. Then press edit and select the option with 2 types of corners. Then, to crop, all you need to do is rotate and resize the image you want. When you're done, be sure to hit the save. To make a collage, you'll need to download a separate app. I personally use photogrid, it's a pretty easy-to-use image editing app. Once you've downloaded the app, or one like this, all you have to do is choose which pictures you want together, and you'll put them in a collage together. You can even change the format and position of your pictures if you don't like the one you chose for you. The same app will also allow you to add a frame to the edges of your pictures. You can do this with a collage of images, or just one, the choice is yours. Just press the border tab and adjust the sliders to make the border. You can even select a frame design and change the color of it until it suits your liking. Here you go. You know now to do basic photo editing. You can also customize the interface of many programs so that you can get the perfect work environment for you. If you're looking for more options for free photo editors, maybe a free online photo editor will have what you need; you can use one in your web browser without having to download the software. To edit photos on your phone or tablet, you need a free photo editing app. If you just want to resize some photos, there are resources for this too. GIMP is probably the most popular free photo editor program. It is full of professional features and offers a very friendly and flexible interface. GIMP's tool boxes, layers, and brush panels are separated from the main canvas, so you can really adjust how you want to work without losing any of the features you need access to. Are various input devices can be installed to expand GIMP functionality, and file formats such as TIFF, PSD, PNG, JPEG, and GIF are supported. There are tutorials on the GIMP website if you need help along the way. You can learn about layer masks, asset folders, brushes, and more. GIMP works with Windows operating systems (10 to 7), Linux and Mac. Similar to GIMP, Paint.NET offers the ability to move Panels around to customize the interface to your liking. Paint.NET also offers plug-ins to support new file formats and add new effects. Includes layers, effects, and a whole host of basic and advanced things, such as a cloned stamp, pencil, text maker, and brush tool. Multiple image file formats are supported, such as BMP, JPEG, TGA, and DDS. Paint.NET is only for Windows computers, especially Windows 10, 8 and 7. Inkscape is a vector graphics editor, more similar to Illustrator, as opposed to a photo handling package, but still has a lot of useful features. The interface may be a little crowded, but that's just proof of the large number of tools it includes. Almost all the tools you will often use are planted along both sides of Inkscape for easy access. Circles, bows, 3D cassettes, ellipses, stars, spirals, and polygons can be created using Inkscape. You can also draw straight or free-hand lines. Tons of file types are supported both when opening and saving. Among many other useful features, you can work with layers, apply a huge number of filters to an image, and use spell checking with the text tool. Like most photo editing programs, Inkscape supports extensions. Inkscape works with Windows, Mac, and Linux operating systems. Windows users can also download a portable version that is perfect for editing directly from a flash drive. Adobe has the free Photoshop Express program that you can use as an alternative to Photoshop if you don't want to pay for their full software. Of course, some of the Photoshop features are missing, so it's not as functional, but still not a lot. When you first open the Photoshop Express image editor, you can upload a picture from your computer or take a new one directly from your webcam. Once a photo is opened in Photoshop Express, the menus on the left make it easy to access all options with one click, such as filters, cropping tools, image corrections, the Red Eye Removal Tool, and more. This photo editor also has borders, an on-site healing brush for a single click touch-ups, effects like grain and fade, and a noise reducer. There's also a button that you can click to quickly see the original photo for comparison with edits. Something really big about this image editor that you won't find in some similar programs is that with almost every tool, you have full control over intensity. This means that you can drag a bar to the left or right to decrease or increase the effect of a tool for get it right. Users of Windows 10, Windows 8.1, Android, iPhone, and iPad can install Photoshop Express. Download for: Krita Desktop is very easy to work with and is certainly an advanced image editor. Like some of these other programs, you can work with layers in addition to many other tools located in a set of tools floating off to the side of the program. There are a lot of other features available, such as brushes and blending modes, advanced selection and masking tools, drawing aids, filters, symmetry tools and effects. A thing worth of is that with pressing the Tab key, you can maximize the canvas to fit the entire screen, get rid of all the menus and tools, so you can have a huge space to work without any distraction. Krita Desktop works with Windows (8.1 and newer), Linux and Mac (10.12 and newer). There is also a portable version for Windows. This free photo editor from InPizio is designed for simplicity, but that doesn't mean it lacks useful features. The program itself is easy to understand and navigate, and you can do everything from adding frames and patterns to cropping, changing brightness, and more. With one-click presets and frames and easy-to-access editing tools, you can finish editing in no time and even share your image directly on Twitter or Flickr from the Share menu. A lot of image file types can be opened in this program, and if you save to your computer, you can choose from JPG, PNG, and TIFF. Some features are only available in the premium version; they are marked in the program with a large Premium banner. InPixio Photo Editor runs on Windows, iPhone, and iPad computers. If you need help using this photo editor, you can refer to their online tutorials. Download For: Pixia has an outdated and unappealing interface, but features and tools are not unwanted for a free photo editor. Layers and layer masks are supported, as well as creating shapes, selecting common photo editing objects and tasks, such as changing color adjustment and tone balance, filling colors, and selecting from different brushes. All standard image file formats can be opened with Pixia, and photos can even be imported directly from the clipboard, camera, or scanner. The latest version requires Windows 10 or 8. Artweaver manages to incorporate tons of useful image editing tools into an easy-to-use program. It has a tabbed interface to avoid clutter, supports the use of pen tablets, and works with some of the most popular image file formats, such as JPEG and PSD. Standard editing tools would be a cropping tool, text, paint bucket, and gradient, among others, included, but Artweaver also allows you to save and resume events, use brushes, create and work with layers, customize the look of palettes, and import images directly from a scanner or camera, among other things. Screen mode can be changed from normal to full screen to have even more space to edit images. PhotoScape has several sections at the top of the program where you can open different tools to perform different actions. Viewer, Editor, Combine and Gif are just some of PhotoScape's sections. The editing feature has dozens of frames to choose from, each with the option to round corners and adjust the frame edge and line settings. You can also add objects and text and crop a picture freely, or use one of the presets (for example, 16:9, Legal Report, and U.S. Business Card Report). Some more tools included in PhotoScape is a red eye remover, clone stamp tool, spot remover, remover, and, among other things, an effect brush (such as grayscale, blurring, darkening, and light). With each tool you select, a description of what it does and how to use it is displayed to the right, which is very useful and not usually a feature included in programs like this. PhotoScape is available for Windows 8–XP, while PhotoScape X is for Windows 10 and macOS. Another program tries to install during installation, but you can easily skip this by deselecting it. The CinePaint interface is very mundane, colorless, and boring, but that doesn't mean the tools aren't useful because they are. Layers are supported so that you can overlay images with each other, change how you blend them, and edit their opacity. You can also get a selection tool with CinePaint, among many other common tools. The first thing you'll notice when you use CinePaint is that when you open a photo for editing, you can't preview it to know that you're selecting the right one, which is a shame.
